

Upcoming Burlington Street Project

The Town of Burlington has received grant money to improve our town streets with a Liquid Road Application. Weather permitting and other projects, the contractor anticipates starting in mid-July.

As with any road improvement project, there will be minor inconveniences during the application and drying of this surface coating. Sections of streets will be done in phases. Lane closures, (possibly 1/2 of the street) will be done at a time and will remain closed until both applications are completed and dried.

Vehicles must be removed from driveways and garages by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your street project and remain out until the next morning or until the road is opened. If barricades are out, that section of road cannot be driven upon until the barricades are removed.

If you live along a highway and enter/exit your property from that highway, you will not be affected by this street project. Only side streets are affected.

Two informational meetings will be held at the Community Building at the Burlington Park on Wednesday, July 14, at 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM for residents/business owners to learn more about this project and ask any questions. Each meeting will cover the same material and is being scheduled at two different times to accommodate for various work schedules.
