Dear Resident:

Jefferson County is always researching and investigating new ways to stretch its paving dollar and to protect the County's asphalt pavement. It is the Highway Department's intention to apply an asphalt emulsion liquid road surface coating to streets in your subdivision. This Liquid Road surface coating is similar to sealcoating, but is thicker, more durable and designed to wear/last longer than ordinary sealcoating.

As with any road improvement project, there will be minor inconveniences during the application and drying of this surface coating. The Highway Department is planning, weather permitting, to apply the road surface coating to your road **starting on or after MONDAY JULY 25, 2022**. We anticipate the lane to be closed for 8-12 hours depending on weather and material drying conditions. Local traffic only will be permitted on roadways during the improvement project.

Vehicles must be removed from driveways and garages by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your street surfacing and remain out until the next morning or until the road is opened. We will remove cones and barricades as soon as the liquid surfacing has cured sufficiently for vehicular traffic.
