

## UPCOMING WORK PLANNED FOR YOUR STREET

August 25, 2023

Dear Resident,

As part of the City of South Bend's Rebuilding Our Streets initiative, your street is scheduled for preventative maintenance work in the coming weeks. The City has contracted with National Pavement Maintenance to perform crack sealing and microsurfacing on the following streets:

- Illinois Street from Western to Linden avenues
- Iowa Street from Western Avenue to Washington Street
- Kenmore Street from Jefferson Boulevard to Western Avenue
- Kenmore Street from Linden Avenue to Washington Street

The project is expected to begin Monday, August 28 with an estimated completion date of Friday, September 8, weather permitting. Rain will alter the schedule. If your street is rained out, it will be scheduled for the following day. The entire schedule may be pushed back according to the weather. Work includes sealing cracks on the street prior to microsurfacing. Once completed, two thin layers of asphalt mix will be applied to the entire street to help seal the roadway. The first coat will be applied in the morning starting around 7 a.m. The second coat will be applied in the early afternoon. The street will remain closed until 9 a.m. the following morning to allow the material to dry properly.

Each street will take two full days to complete. **During construction, each street will be closed for two days.** No Parking signs will be posted on the street 48 hours prior to work beginning. Street parking will not be available during that time.

We recognize the inconvenience this poses and greatly appreciate your patience and understanding. If you have any concerns or questions regarding this notice, contact me or the City Inspector. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and patience during this project.
